RECOGNISING the objective of the proposed treaty to establish an international system of protection of broadcasting organisations without compromising the rights of holders of copyright and related rights in works and other protected subject matter carried by broadcasts, as well as the need for broadcasting organisations to acknowledge these rights,

STRESSING the benefits to authors, performers and producers of phonograms of effective protection against illegal use of broadcasts and broadcast signals,

EMPHASISING our desire to conclude an international treaty for the protection of broadcasting organisations that will continue to protect and promote cultural diversity under the frame work of the UNESCO Convention on the Protection and Promotion of the Diversity of Cultural Expressions,
